**Danish producer responsibility's new producer responsibility register is open for reporting of quantities up to 31 March 2020.**

Dear producers and importers

The annual statutory reporting of quantities of electrical and electronic equipment, batteries, and vehicles placed on the market, collected, and subjected to environmental treatment has now started, and the system is open for entries.

Please note that the reporting system has been changed further to new statutory requirements from the EU Commission.

## Quantitative reporting of electronics, batteries, and vehicles 2020

If you are a member of a collective scheme you do not report yourself; those data that you have reported to the collective scheme will be transferred to DPA-System!

## Please note these dates!

You must yourself report portable batteries to SKAT no later than 15 February.

An auditor or the management must authenticate reporting of categories of electronics. This authentication must be signed no later than 31 May.

Everybody must log in and sign a reporting declaration when all data have been entered. This must be done no later than 31 March.

## Reporting deadline

Reporting must be done no later than 31 March 2020.

Non-reporting leads to your company being deleted from the register after which it is illegal to place the products on the market in Denmark.

A re-registration triggers a new registration fee.
